Outdoor and Ground-Mounted Boxes Outdoor boxes should be installed at least 3 feet (≈ 0.9 meters) above the ground to prevent water ingress and dirt accumulation. Ground-mounted boxes should be slightly elevated, typically 2 to 4 inches, to avoid moisture damage.

IEC 61439: Governs the design, testing, and construction of low-voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies, ensuring panels meet safety and performance standards.
