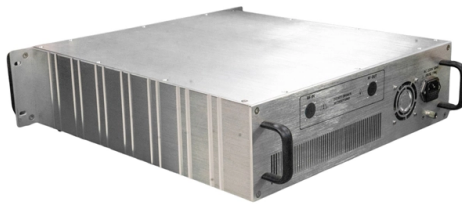


How to access the internet via a fiber optic router

Step 4: Configure the Router

Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1). Enter ISP credentials if required. Update the router firmware to ensure optimal performance and security.

Step 5: Test Your Connection

Connect a device via Wi-Fi or Ethernet and check for internet access. Run a speed test to verify fiber optic speeds. If the connection fails, reboot the ONT and router or contact your ISP.

Tips for Optimal Performance

- Avoid bending or damaging fiber cables, as they are fragile.
- Place the router centrally in your home for better Wi-Fi coverage.
- Use high-quality Ethernet cables (Cat6 or higher) to maintain full-speed performance.
- Ensure both ONT and router are near power outlets and in a dry, ventilated area.
