

How to connect a 6-core fiber optic cable to a switch cable

Termination: If using bulk fiber, terminate each strand with LC connectors following proper polishing and cleaning procedures. Pre-terminated cables simplify this step.

Step-by-Step Connection

- Insert the SFP/SFP+ modules into the switch ports.
- Connect the first duplex pair (fibers 1 and 2) to the first SFP module, ensuring TX/RX orientation.
- Connect the second duplex pair (fibers 3 and 4) to the second SFP module.
- Connect the third duplex pair (fibers 5 and 6) to the third SFP module.

If using a patch panel, route the fibers through the panel before connecting to the switch. Verify connections and clean all connectors to minimize signal loss. Configure the switch to recognize the fiber ports and test connectivity.
