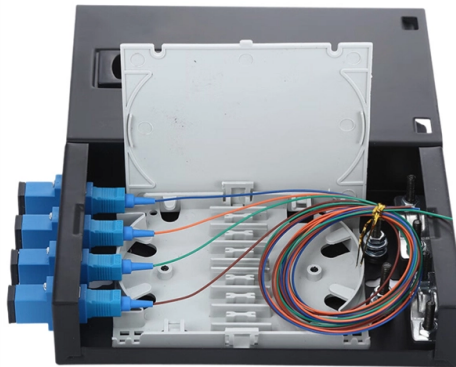

Configure network settings as needed, including Wi-Fi SSID, password, and optional Quality of Service (QoS) for prioritizing traffic. Verify the internet connection on your devices to ensure the setup is working correctly.
