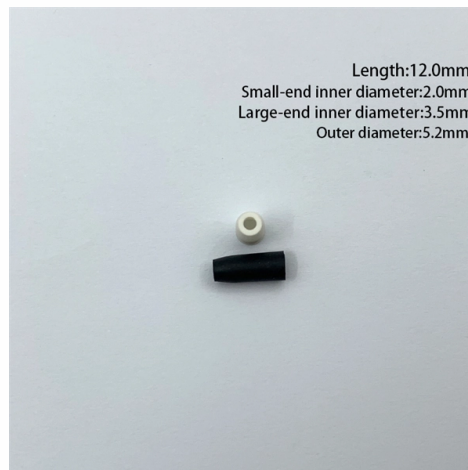


How to connect cables to the fiber optic panel box

Fusion Splicing: Permanently join fibers using a fusion splicer for minimal signal loss.

Mechanical Splicing or Pre-Terminated Connectors: Insert fibers into adapters or connector couplers (LC, SC, ST, or MTP/MPO) according to the panel's port layout.

Routing and Securing: Route fibers along the designated paths inside the box, using bend radius control clips and cable ties to prevent sharp bends or tension. Store excess fiber neatly in splice trays or cable management sections.

Labeling: Mark each port and cable for easy identification during troubleshooting or future maintenance.
