

How to connect the fiber optic cable to the repeater

- Repeater mode:** If using a router as a repeater, enable "Repeater Mode" or "Bridge Mode" in the router settings and configure the SSID and password to match your main network.

- Check signal quality:** Ensure the fiber link has minimal attenuation and the repeater's LEDs indicate a stable connection.
- Test network access:** Connect a device to the repeater...
