Horizontal Busbar Positioning Horizontal busbars can be rear-mounted or top-mounted. Rear-mounted horizontal busbars offer superior thermal performance because they avoid heat accumulation from circuit breakers and functional units, allowing higher current ratings without oversizing copper. This configuration also reduces mechanical stress and simplifies handling, lowering both weight and cost while maintaining electrical performance. Top-mounted busbars, in contrast, may experience higher ambient temperatures and require larger cross-sections to compensate.

Connection to Circuit Breakers Proper connection between busbars and MCCBs is critical for safety and reliability. Common methods include:

- Direct bolt connection:** MCCB terminals are bolted directly to the busbar, ensuring metal-to-metal contact. Correct torque is essential to prevent overheating and high-resistance joints.
- Lug-based connection:** Compression lugs or mechanical connectors provide flexibility when alignment is difficult but require careful maintenance to avoid loose connections.
