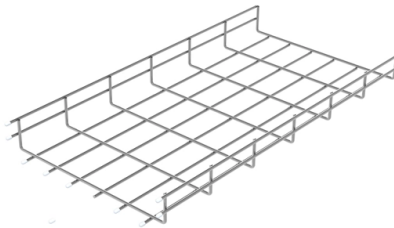


How to connect to a Layer 2 switch



AI Overview

To connect a Layer 2 switch, physically link devices to the switch ports, assign VLANs to access ports, configure trunk ports for inter-switch communication, and optionally connect a router for Layer 3 services.

Physical Connection

Connect End Devices: Each workstation, server, or network device should be connected to a separate switch port. Each port represents an individual collision domain, allowing full-duplex communication for maximum bandwidth.

Inter-Switch Links: If multiple switches are used, connect them using trunk ports to carry multiple VLANs across switches.

Router Connection (Optional): For Internet access or inter-VLAN routing, connect a router to a trunk port on the switch. The router will act as the gateway for devices on different VLANs.

VLAN Configuration

Access Ports: Assign each switch port to a specific VLAN to segment the network. For example, port GigabitEthernet0/0/2 can be assigned to VLAN 2 using commands like `port link-type access` and `port default vlan 2`.

Trunk Ports: Configure ports connecting to other switches or routers as trunk ports to carry multiple VLANs. For example, `port trunk allow-pass vlan 2 3` allows VLAN 2 and 3 traffic to pass through the trunk.

MAC Address Table: The switch dynamically learns MAC addresses of connected devices and forwards frames accordingly. Static MAC addresses can also be configured to bind a device to a specific port.

Integration with Router

Sub-Interfaces or VLANIF: Configure the router with sub-interfaces or VLANIF interfaces to terminate VLAN tags and provide Layer 3 forwarding between VLANs.

DHCP and NAT: The router can serve as a DHCP server to assign IP addresses and enable NAT for Internet access.

Best Practices

Segmentation: Use VLANs to separate departments or groups for better traffic management and security.

Full-Duplex Mode: Enable full-duplex on all ports to maximize bandwidth and reduce collisions.

Redundancy: Consider port-channel links between switches for higher bandwidth and redundancy.

Documentation: Keep a record of VLAN assignments, trunk configurati...
