

How to connect two optical splitters and one ONU

- Split Ratios:** The combination of first- and second-stage split ratios determines the total number of ONUs served by a single OLT port. For example, a 1:8 first-stage splitter followed by a 1:4 second-stage splitter can serve 32 ONUs.
- Signal Isolation:** There is no direct optical channel between ONUs on the splitter; communication between ONUs is managed by the OLT or higher-layer network devices.
- Deployment Flexibility:** Two-stage splitting is often used in rural or wide-area deployments to reduce fiber usage and optimize cost, while single-stage splitting is more common in dense urban areas.
- Passive Operation:** Both splitters are passive devices, requiring no power, which simplifies maintenance and reduces ope...
