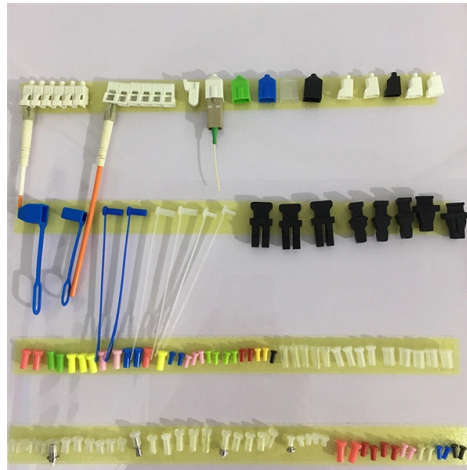


How to determine the size of a fiber optic patch cord

The size of a fiber optic patch cord is determined by its core and cladding diameters, typically expressed as a ratio like 9/125 μm , along with the outer jacket diameter. Understanding Fiber Size

Fiber optic patch cords are specified by core and cladding dimensions. The first number indicates the core diameter, where light travels, and the second number indicates the cladding diameter, which is usually standardized at 125 μm for most telecom and data applications (e.g., 9/125 for single-mode, 50/125 or 62.5/125 for multimode). Small variations like 8/125 or 10/125 exist but generally have negligible impact on performance.

Jacket and Cable Diameter

Beyond the fiber itself, patch cords have a buffer coating and outer jacket that protect the fiber. Common jacket diameters for duplex patch cords include 1.6mm, 1.8mm, 2.0mm, 2.5mm, and 3.0mm, depending on the cable style (Mini-Zip, Zip Twin, or Flat Twin). The jacket size affects flexibility, handling, and suitability for high-density installations.

Identifying Fiber Type

Patch cords are also classified by fiber type:

- Single-mode (SMF):** Narrow core (9 μm), supports long-distance transmission with minimal attenuation. Often labeled OS1 or OS2.
- Multimode (MMF):** Larger core (50 μm or 62.5 μm), supports multiple light modes, ideal for short-distance, high-bandwidth applications. Common grades include OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, and OM5.

Reading Patch Cord Specifications

A typical patch cord specification might look like: G657A1 9/125 Duplex LC/UPC-LC/UPC 2.0mm 3m LSZH. Breaking it down:

- G657A1:** Fiber bend-insensitive type
- 9/125:** Core/cladding size in microns
- Duplex:** Two fibers in one cable
- LC/UPC-LC/UPC:** Connector types and polish
- 2.0mm:** Jacket diameter
- 3m:** Cable length
- LSZH:** Low-smoke zero-halogen jacket material
