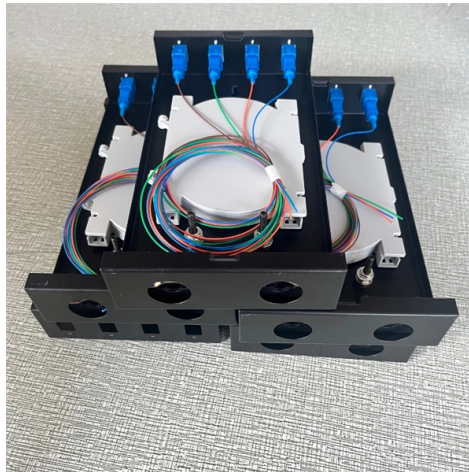


How to disconnect the optical fiber from the optical module
