

How to install cable trays

- 3. Preparing Materials and Tools**Ensure all materials and tools are available, including cable trays, couplers, mounting brackets, threaded rods, anchor bolts, grounding straps, power drills, wrenches, hacksaws, and files. Inspect trays and accessories for damage before installation.
- 4. Installing Supports**Install supports at regular intervals, typically every 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load. Supports can be wall-mounted (cantilever brackets) or ceiling-suspended (trapeze or C-hanger). Ensure supports are level and secure using anchors, threaded rods, and nuts. Proper support prevents sagging and maintains structural integrity.
- 5. Mounting and Aligning Trays**Attach trays to the supports using connectors and fittings. Align trays straight and level, and cut trays to fit corners or specific lengths as needed. Always deburr cut edges to prevent cable damage. For multi-layer installations, maintain vertical separation (e.g., 30 cm) between layers to avoid interference.
- 6. Grounding and Labeling**Connect grounding straps to ensure electrical safety. Clearly label each tray with feeder names or branch numbers for easy identi...
