Ensure clear separation of live, neutral, and earth conductors, and maintain manufacturer-recommended clearances for heat dissipation and maintenance.
- Mounting and Accessibility** Wall mounting is common for light to medium boxes, while floor pedestals or skid mounts suit heavier double-layer boxes. Ensure breakers and switches are reachable from standing height (1.2–1.6 m) and that hinged doors can open fully without obstruction.
