Provide additional support at bends, branches, and offsets to prevent sagging. **Tray Installation** Lift tray sections onto supports and secure them using hold-down clips, bolts, or couplers. Align trays straight and level, joining sections end-to-end. For long runs, use cable tray rollers to facilitate smooth cable pulling and prevent kinks. Cut trays to fit specific lengths or corners, and deburr all cut edges to avoid damaging cable insulation. **Cable Laying and Management** Lay cables neatly, separating by voltage and function. Use cable ties or straps to organize conductors, leaving slack for expansion or future adjustments. Ensure proper cable fill ratios (typically max 50%) to prevent overheating.
