- Always turn off the main breaker before performing maintenance or connecting new circuits .
- Check breaker ratings to ensure circuits are not overloaded .
- Maintain proper grounding to prevent electrical shocks .
- Balance loads across phases to avoid overheating and energy loss .
- Use insulated tools and wear protective equipment when working inside the box .
