5. Use Swivel or Rotating Connectors for Pulling: If the cable is being pulled during installation, attach the pulling rope to a swivel connector on the strength member to prevent twisting. This is especially important for long runs or conduit installations.
6. Protect Splice Points and Junctions: When tying cables near splice closures or junction boxes, ensure that the cable is supported without stress and that the splice point is centered and protected with heat-shrink sleeves or splice trays.
