

How to use an SFP fiber optic switch

- Vendor Considerations:** Using manufacturer-approved modules (e.g., Ubiquiti UF-SM-1G, UF-MM-10G) ensures plug-and-play compatibility, though third-party MSA-compliant modules can also work.
- Fiber Cable Selection**
 - Patch Cables:** LC-LC duplex cables are standard for SFP connections.
 - Direct Attach Copper (DAC):** For very short distances (up to 10 meters), twin-ax copper cables with SFP connectors can be used instead of fiber.
- Distance Considerations:** Multimode is limited to hundreds of meters, while single-mode can span several kilometers.

Installation Steps

- Power Down:** Turn off the switch to prevent electrical damage, unless the device supports hot-swapping.
- ESD Protection:** Use an anti-static wrist strap or touch a grounded surface to discharge static electricity.
- Insert SFP Module:** Align the module with the SFP slot, ensuring TX/RX orientation matches the cable direction, and gently push until it clicks.
