Testing and Documentation: Verify all splices with OTDR or other testing equipment. Document each splice for future maintenance and troubleshooting.

Maintenance Protocol: Conduct regular inspections quarterly or after severe weather. Check for cracks, dust, debris, or corrosion inside the enclosure. Clean and reseal as needed to maintain signal integrity.
