Insert the Fiber into the Cold Joint Slowly insert the prepared fiber into the mechanical splicing mechanism of the SC cold joint. The internal V-shaped groove and clamping element will hold the fiber securely. Ensure the fiber is fully seated before removing any wedge clips.

Lock the Fiber Press the gland or locking mechanism to secure the fiber in place. This ensures proper alignment and prevents movement that could degrade signal quality.

Install the Protective Boot Slide the connector boot over the joint to provide mechanical protection and environmental sealing. For cold-shrink power or telecom joints, the EPDM rubber tubing will contract around the cable, creating a tight, corrosion-resistant seal without heat.

- Avoid Contamination:** Keep the joint away from dust and dirt, as contamination can reduce performance.
- Handle Fiber Carefully:** Insert fibers slowly to prevent breakage or poor transmission.
- Use Proper Cutting Tools:** Automatic fiber cleavers provide the best results for clean, precise cuts.
- No Heat Required:** Cold-shrink joints are safe to install in environments with combustible gases since no flame or hot work is needed.
