

How to use the online tester for optocoupler modules

The tester is portable and suitable for checking optocouplers in miner PSUs like Antminer, Whatsminer, Avalon, Innosilicon, and IceRiver. For SMD or plug-in optocouplers, follow the same principle but ensure proper alignment with the tester's socket. Never test while the board is powered on to avoid damage or injury. By following these steps, you can efficiently verify the condition of optocoupler modules and troubleshoot faults in electronic circuits or miner power supplies.
