

Installation Method of Concealed Wall Panel for Distribution Box

For concealed installations, there should be no gaps around the box, and edges should be flush with the wall. Apply anti-corrosion paint to contact surfaces between the box and the wall to prevent rusting.

Step 4: Electrical Component Assembly Verify all components (circuit breakers, busbars, terminal blocks) match the technical drawings and are undamaged. Install components inside the box according to manufacturer instructions, ensuring proper spacing and alignment.

Step 5: Wiring Connections Connect the incoming power lines (phase, neutral, and ground) to the appropriate terminals. For spiral fuses, connect the power wire to the intermediate contact and the load wire to the threaded terminal. Separate busbars for neutral (N) and protective earth (PE) should be used, with clear labeling and no splicing. Ensure all connections are tight and comply with torque specifications provided by the manufacturer.
