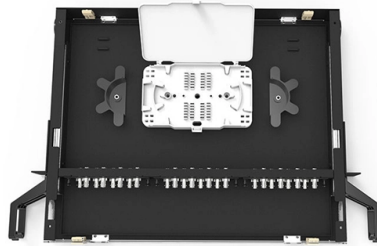

Circuit Breaker Installation: Install independent breakers according to the load requirements, ensuring each circuit has proper protection.

Terminal Connections: Connect phase wires to phase terminals, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground. Use a wire stripper or screw-tightening method to ensure secure, conductive connections.
