- 3. Internal Layout and Component Installation** Inside the distribution box, use DIN rails or molded mounting pillars to secure circuit breakers, terminal blocks, and other components. Ensure proper spacing to prevent overheating and allow easy access for maintenance. For waterproof boxes, compress gaskets fully and use sealed cable glands to prevent moisture ingress, which can compromise electrical safety.
