As per the NEC, the maximum allowable rung spacing is 9 inches (230 mm) when cable tray carries sin-gle-conductor cables of 1/0 to 4/0 AWG (American Wire Gauge) (Appendix I).

Cable Tray

All changes of direction must be supported in the immediate vicinity of the joints (distance $\leq$ 150 mm) by an appropriate supporting structure. Inclined cable trays
