A fiber optic distribution box (also called a fiber distribution enclosure or FDB) serves as a centralized point for terminating, organizing, and distributing fiber optic cables to multiple users or devices. It is commonly deployed in shared spaces like building corridors, outdoor poles, or underground vaults and is designed to handle multiple fibers, optical splitters, and connectors. Distribution boxes focus on efficient fiber management, easy access for maintenance, and scalability for FTTH or FTTB networks.
