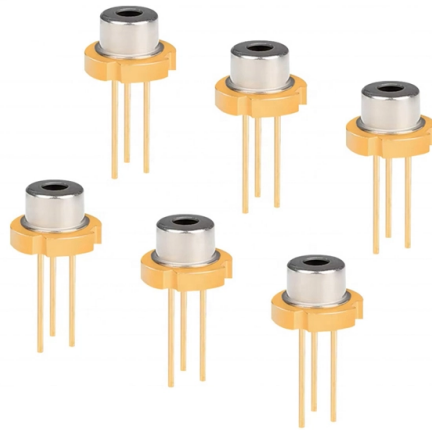

While optical cables are not covered by the RoHS Directive, they must still comply with general safety and performance standards, including the Low Voltage Directive and Construction Products Regulation if applicable. Non-compliant or defective cables may not legally be sold, especially if they fail to meet safety, labeling, or technical documentation requirements (Compliance Gate) . Even if the defect is minor, failure to disclose it to buyers can constitute misrepresentation or breach of warranty.
