Even cables that appear intact may have invisible tension damage, requiring specialized testing equipment like an OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) to detect. Additionally, while fiber itself does not emit electromagnetic radiation, the fiber optic converters and routers that convert optical signals to electrical signals can generate electromagnetic interference (EMI). This EMI can propagate through home wiring and affect sensitive electronics, potentially causing operational issues or increased electrical sensitivity in some individuals.
