

KVM Switch Signal Lines

Overview of KVM Signal Lines

- Keyboard signals:** Typically transmitted via USB or PS/2 lines. These lines carry keystroke data from the KVM switch to the selected computer.
- Mouse signals:** Also transmitted via USB or PS/2 lines, allowing the KVM to relay pointer movements and clicks to the active computer.
- Optional audio or USB hub lines:** Some KVM switches include additional lines for audio or USB peripheral sharing.

Pinout and Direction

KVM cables have specific pinouts that define which pins carry which signals. The direction is always from the KVM switch to the computer, meaning the cable must be connected correctly to ensure proper signal flow.

For example:

- VGA lines carry red, green, blue, horizontal sync, vertical sync, and ground signals.
- USB lines carry data+ (D+), data- (D-), power (Vcc), and ground.
- PS/2 lines carry clock and data signals for keyboard and mouse.

Incorrect connections or mismatched adapters can prevent signal transmission, causing issues like “no signal” on the monitor or unresponsive keyboard/mouse.

Troubleshooting Signal Issues

Common problems with KVM signal lines include:

- Missing or loose cables:** Ensure all video, keyboard, and mouse lines are securely connected.
- Adapter incompatibility:** USB-C, DisplayPort, or HDMI adapters must match the KVM's input/output specifications.
- Directionality issues:** Some DisplayPort to HDMI adapters only work in one direction; using them backward can block video signals.
