Short pulses at low repetition rates generally allow the diode to operate safely at higher peak powers without damage, whereas long pulses or high repetition rates increase thermal stress. Ambient Conditions: Operating temperature and environmental conditions affect reliability. Modules exposed to high ambient temperatures or poor ventilation degrade faster, even under pulsed operation. Practical Implications Pulsed high beam modules are often preferred in applications requiring high peak intensity but moderate average power, such as measurement, scanning, or signaling. While pulsing can extend life, the module will eventually degrade, typically showing reduced optical output before complete failure.
