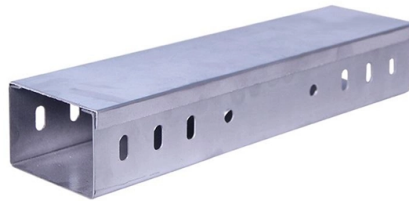


Light bulbs are installed inside the distribution box

A light bulb is connected to a distribution box by running a live and neutral wire from the appropriate circuit breaker to the fixture, with proper grounding for safety.

Step-by-Step Connection Process

1. **Safety First:** Always turn off the main power supply before working on any electrical connections to prevent electric shock.
2. **Identify the Circuit:** Determine which circuit in the distribution box will power the light. Each circuit is protected by a Miniature Circuit Breaker (MCB) or fuse.
3. **Wiring from the Distribution Box:** Connect the live (phase) wire from the selected MCB to the live terminal of the light circuit. Connect the neutral wire from the neutral bus bar in the distribution box to the neutral terminal of the light circuit. Ensure the earth (ground) wire is connected from the earth bus bar to the light fixture if it has a metal body.
4. **Routing to the Light Fixture:** Run the wires through conduits or cable channels to the light fixture. In a junction box, you can make the connections safely and neatly, ensuring all wires are properly insulated.
5. **Connecting the Light Fixture:** At the fixture, connect the live wire to the live terminal, the neutral wire to the neutral terminal, and the earth wire to the grounding point. For multiple lights on the same circuit, use parallel connections so each light can operate independently.
6. **Testing:** After all connections are made, turn on the main power and test the light. Use a multimeter to verify voltage and ensure there are no short circuits.

Additional Considerations

- Wire Size:** Choose the correct wire gauge based on the load and distance to prevent overheating and voltage drop.
- Circuit Protection:** Ensure the MCB rating matches the load of the light circuit to avoid overloading.
- Earthing:** Proper grounding is essential for safety, especially for metal fixtures, to prevent electric shock.
- Switches:** If using a wall switch, connect it in series with the live wire to control the light.
