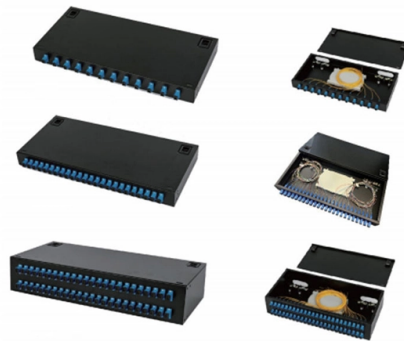

OSFP (Octal Small Form-factor Pluggable): Another 400 Gbps module, OSFP supports 8 lanes of 50–53 Gbps PAM4 electrical signals and is designed for high-performance data center applications, providing a balance between size and power efficiency.

Key Considerations
Fiber Type: Single-mode fibers are used for long-distance communication, while multi-mode fibers are suitable for shorter distances within buildings or campuses.

Form Factor: Smaller modules like SFP and SFP+ are ideal for high-density environments, whereas larger modules like CFP and OSFP are used where higher bandwidth is required.

Applications: Modules are selected based on network speed requirements, distance, and deployment environment, ranging from enterprise LANs to cloud data centers and telecom backbones.
