Tracer wires run alongside the cable and can be detected with electromagnetic tools. They should be left slightly above ground at access points for future detection.
Marker balls emit signals detectable by specialized locators, providing an additional method to identify cable routes.
4. Ground-Penetrating Radar (GPR) GPR sends radar pulses into the ground to create images of subsurface objects. It is particularly effective for detecting non-metallic fiber optic cables. While highly accurate, GPR requires skilled operators and specialized equipment.
5. Hydrovac Excavation For precise exposure of buried cables without causing damage, hydrovac excavation uses pressurized water to safely uncover the cable. This method is useful when exact cable positioning is required for construction or repair work.
