

Malawi adds new internet data center



AI Overview

Malawi has inaugurated its first national data center in Blantyre to enhance digital services, data security, and government interoperability. The government of Malawi has officially launched its first national data center in Blantyre, the country's second-largest city, as part of its broader digital transformation agenda under the Malawi 2063 vision and the Digital Malawi Project (DIGMAP). The facility, built in partnership with Huawei, is designed to host all government-wide systems, providing a centralized platform for data storage, cloud services, disaster recovery, and e-government operations.

Purpose and Strategic Importance The data center aims to consolidate government systems, eliminating fragmented, siloed operations and enabling interoperability between government departments, third-party organizations, and private sector systems. This integration is expected to improve service delivery, enhance coordination across ministries, and support digital innovation. President Lazarus Chakwera emphasized that the facility will allow Malawi to leverage emerging technologies such as artificial intelligence, digital financial services, and the Internet of Things (IoT), while also reducing operational costs and improving data security.

Technical Features The Blantyre data center is part of a national ICT infrastructure initiative, including the Malawi National Fibre Backbone Project, which aims to expand broadband connectivity across major cities. The facility uses hyper-converged infrastructure (HCI), integrating computing, storage, networking, and virtualization into a unified system, ensuring efficient management and scalability. While specific technical specifications were not disclosed, the center is designed to serve as the primary hub for government data, with a secondary/backup data center planned in Lilongwe to ensure business continuity.
