For power line applications, the CFE E1000-21 specification defines requirements for optical ground wires (OPGW) and guard cables with optical fibers, covering voltages from 34.5 kV to 400 kV. It includes mechanical, environmental, and corrosion testing procedures, as well as aluminum-magnesium-silicon conductors and fiber measurement methods. Cable Types and Construction Mexican optical cables include several types for outdoor and industrial use: ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) Cables: Fully dielectric, self-supporting, suitable for spans up to 800 meters without messenger wires. Typically used along power lines up to 220 kV. They can have one or two polyethylene sheaths and accommodate up to 288 fibers. ASU Cables: Single loose tube, water-blocking gel, self-supporting, suitable for short spans (80-120 meters). Includes FRP support elements and PE outer jacket. GYTS/GYTS-A Cables: Armored aerial cables with metallic protection, rodent resistance, and water-blocking compounds. Fibers are in loose tubes with fillers braided around a reinforcing member, covered by a PE jacke...
