This procedure, usually involving holding the switch in a specific position for several seconds, frequently resolves situations where the roof. To reset a sunroof, press and hold the "Close" or "Tilt" button for 15 to 30 seconds until the glass moves slightly or you hear a clicking sound, indicating the motor has re-established its home position.
