These converters support multiple data rates and protocols, including Ethernet and Fibre Channel, and can extend network distances up to 140 km for Fast Ethernet and 80 km for Gigabit Ethernet. They are cost-effective, do not void switch warranties, and can be installed as standalone units or in racks. 2. Mode Conditioning Patch Cables (MCP) Mode conditioning patch cables are specialized duplex cables that offset-splice SMF to MMF, controlling the launch of the laser to prevent differential mode delay (DMD).
