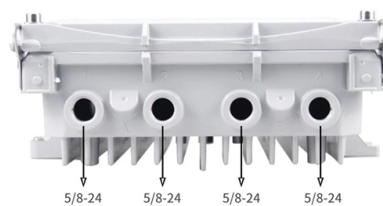

Installation Guidelines Qualified personnel should follow a pre-determined layout plan, considering building codes, equipment specifications, and clearances.

Support spacing: Maximum support spacing is typically 3.6 meters, with center-hung tray supports allowing easier cable placement.

Load capacity: Each hanger supports 318–340 kg (700–750 lbs).

Fastening: Installation requires minimal tools, typically an M8 bolt and a 13 mm wrench, with fewer fasteners needed due to tray design.

Bend radius: Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables exiting the tray to prevent damage.

Rung spacing: Ladder trays should have 6–9 inches (150–230 mm) spacing for optimal cable support.
