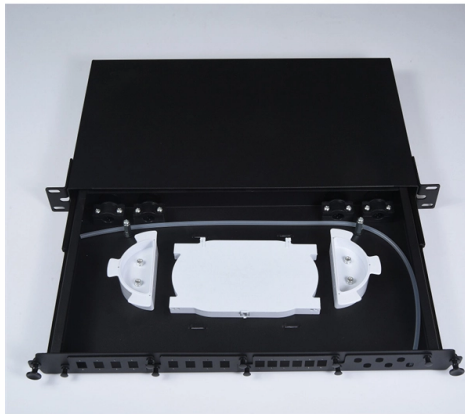

4. Mounting and Installation: Outdoor boxes are typically surface-mounted to maintain rain-tight integrity. The front edge should be set back no more than 6 mm from the finished surface per NEC 312.3. Avoid placing boxes in direct spray or standing water, and ensure proper drainage and sloped roofs to divert rain.
5. Thermal and Environmental Management: Sun exposure and internal loads can raise temperatures. Incorporate ventilation, thermal regulation, or breathable membranes to manage condensation and heat buildup without compromising sealing.
6. Compliance and Safety: Ensure compliance with NEC Article 312, UL 50/50E standards, and local electrical codes. Outdoor boxes must protect both equipment and personnel, providing proper grounding, overcurrent protection, and secure cabl...
