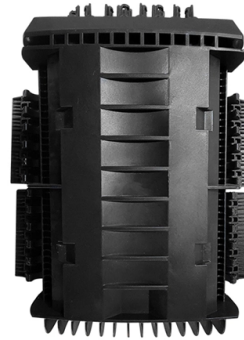

Label and organize: Clearly label each fiber strand and port to simplify troubleshooting and future changes. Connect patch cords: Plug the fiber patch cables from the panel ports to the corresponding equipment ports, ensuring the correct mode and connector type.
