Ensure neat cable management, proper insulation, and clear wire labeling. All cable inlets and cover joints should be sealed with no visible gaps to prevent moisture ingress (). Safety and Grounding The metal enclosure, electrical board, and internal appliances must be properly grounded. The protective neutral wire should be securely connected through the terminal board. Include circuit protection devices such as breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit (). Concrete Installation Considerations Use on-site mixed concrete suitable for embedding electrical boxes. Ensure formwork protection to prevent damage to the box during pouring. Boxes should allow for flush-mounted inserts like switches, sockets, or LED...
