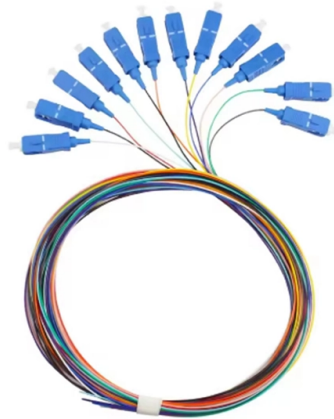


Requirements for replacing the crossbeam of the distribution box
