Ring networks use access methods like token passing, slotted rings, and Device Level Ring (DLR) protocols to control data transmission and ensure redundancy. Overview of Ring Network Access Methods In a ring network, each node connects to exactly two other nodes, forming a continuous loop. Data travels from node to node, and access methods determine which node can transmit data at a given time to prevent collisions and ensure orderly communication .1. Token Passing Mechanism: A special data packet called a token circulates around the ring. A node can only transmit data when it holds the token. Advantages: Prevents collisions, ensures fair access, and is predictable in terms of latency. Examples: IBM Token Ring (802.5) networks use token passing at the data link layer, even if the physical topology is a star .2. Slotted Ring Mechanism: The ring is treated as a large shift register divided into fixed-size slots. Nodes insert data into empty slots and remove it after it circulates. Advantages: Efficient bandwidth utilization and predictable timing. Example: Cambridge Ring networks implement slotted ring access .3. Device Level Ring (DLR) Mechanism: Used in industrial Ethernet networks, DLR is a Layer 2 protocol that provides fast fault detection and recovery. One node acts as a ring supervisor, monitoring beacon frames to detect failures. Other nodes pass data and report faults. Redundancy: Supports redundant gateways and automatic switchover in case of link or node failu...
