

Router to Fiber Optic Converter

To connect a router to a fiber optic converter, link the fiber cable to the converter or ONT, then connect the converter's Ethernet port to your router's WAN port, and power on both devices.

Handle the fiber cable carefully to avoid bending or damaging it, as improper handling can degrade signal quality.

Step 3: Connect the Converter to the Router

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the converter's RJ45 Ethernet port (or ONT LAN port) to your router's WAN port. Ensure the cable is securely plugged in to prevent intermittent connectivity.

Step 4: Power On Devices

Connect the power adapters to the converter/ONT and the router. Wait for the status lights to stabilize, which may take 2–5 minutes. The lights indicate a successful fiber link and Ethernet connection.

Step 5: Configure the Router

Access the router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1). Set up your WAN connection type according to your ISP's instructions (DHCP, PPPoE, or static IP). Configure Wi-Fi settings, including SSID and password, and enable security protocols like WPA3 for optimal protection. Optionally, enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP, gaming, or video streaming to prioritize traffic.

Step 6: Test the Connection

Verify that the router's WAN light is active and that connected d...
