Overview of Fiber Optic Network Diagrams

Key Components in a Fiber Network Diagram

- Central Office (CO):** The main hub housing core switching equipment and media converters that transform electrical signals into optical signals for long-distance transmission.
- Feeder Cables:** High-capacity fibers connecting the CO to distribution points, often using single-mode fiber for long distances.
- Fiber Distribution Hub (FDH):** Contains splitters in Passive Optical Networks (PONs) to distribute signals to multiple subscribers.
- Distribution Cables:** Carry signals from FDH to neighborhoods or buildings.
- Drop Cables:** Connect the distribution network to the subscriber's premises.
- Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Converts optical signals back to electrical signals for end-user devices.
- Media Converters:** Used in residential setups to interface fiber with copper-based devices.

Common Network Topologies

- Point-to-Point (P2P):** Each subscriber has a dedicated fiber link to the CO, offering high bandwidth but requiring more fiber.
- Point-to-Multipoint (P2MP) / PON:** A single fiber from the CO is split to serve multiple users, reducing fiber usage and cost, commonly used in FTTH deployments.

Single-Mode vs Multimode Fiber

- Single-Mode Fiber:** Small core, ideal for long-distance transmission with minimal signal loss, typi...
