Step 5: Optimize Your Network Router placement: Position centrally in your home, away from obstructions, for maximum coverage. Wired connections: Use Ethernet for devices requiring high-speed, low-latency connections like gaming consoles or PCs. Monitor performance: Test internet speed and adjust settings if necessary. Consider Wi-Fi 6/6e routers to fully leverage fiber speeds.
