

Setting up connection between two core switches



AI Overview

Two core switches can be interconnected using trunk links, fiber or Ethernet connections, and proper VLAN and IP configuration to enable routing and redundancy.

Physical Connection Choose the appropriate media: For long-distance or high-speed connections, use fiber optic cables with compatible transceivers (e.g., 1000BaseLH) between the switches. For shorter distances, Cat5e/Cat6 Ethernet cables can be used .Select the ports: Use dedicated uplink or trunk ports on each switch. Some switches provide dual-purpose ports that can auto-detect MDI/MDIX, simplifying direct connections .Cabling type: For direct switch-to-switch connections, a crossover cable may be required if auto-MDI/MDIX is not supported. For fiber, ensure the transceivers and fiber type match on both ends .

Logical Configuration

VLAN setup: Create a transport VLAN on both switches to carry inter-switch traffic. Assign a unique VLAN ID and configure the corresponding interface with an IP address for routing purposes (e.g., 10.0.0.1 on Switch1, 10.0.0.2 on Switch2), .

Trunk configuration: Configure the inter-switch ports as trunk ports to allow multiple VLANs to pass through. Example for Cisco switches:
`CodeCopy`
`switchport mode trunk`
`switchport trunk allowed vlan`
 This ensures that VLAN traffic is properly tagged and routed between switches .

Routing: If each switch manages its own VLANs, configure static routes or a routing protocol (e.g., OSPF) to enable communication between VLANs across the two switches .

Advanced Considerations

Link Aggregation: For higher bandwidth and redundancy, consider EtherChannel or LACP to bundle multiple physical links into a single logical link .

Spanning Tree Protocol (STP): Ensure STP is enabled to prevent loops in the network, especially if multiple interconnections exist .
