 - IEC/IS Standards:** IEC 60529 for IP ratings, IEC 60947 for low-voltage switchgear, and IS 13703 for LV fuses.
 - UL 50/50E:** Certification for outdoor enclosures ensuring durability and safety.

Typical Dimensions Dimensions vary depending on the number of circuits, voltage, and amperage. Examples include:

- Small units:** 300–400 mm width x 400–600 mm height x 150–250 mm depth, suitable for residential or small commercial applications.
- Medium units:** 600–800 mm width x 800–1200 mm height x 300–400 mm depth, for industrial or large commercial use.
- Large/feeder pillar boxes:** Custom sizes for medium-voltage distribution, often exceeding 1000 mm...
