Fiberglass trays are often pultruded or molded, with resin content maintained between 45–65% by weight for structural integrity. Dimensions and Load Ratings Cable ladder trays are available in various nominal depths, commonly 51 mm (2"), 76 mm (3"), 127 mm (5"), 178 mm (7"), and 229 mm (9") to accommodate different cable volumes. Safe Working Load (SWL) is declared per IEC 61537, with load vs. span tables provided by manufacturers. Maximum deflection is measured at mid-span for single-span installations, and continuous spans may allow higher load ratings. Standards and Compliance European-style trays must comply with CE marking requirements, demonstrating conformity with European directives and national regulations. Compliance is often verified by third-party certification bodies such as LCIE, IMQ, or UL for mechanical and electrical safety. Trays are designed according to ISO 1461 for galvanization and ASTM A123 for structural steel, ensuring durability and corrosion resistance.
