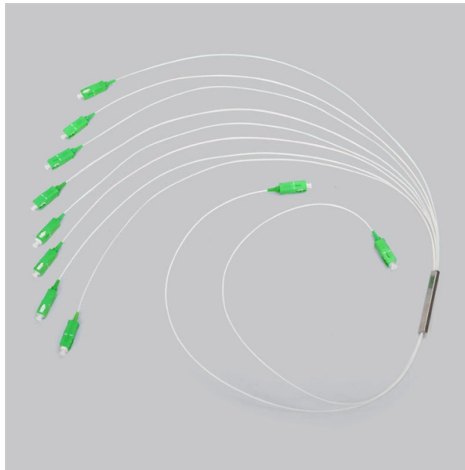


Splicing loss of wind power communication optical cables
