

Straight-line installation of fiber optic cables on iron towers



AI Overview

Fiber optic cables on iron towers should be installed using proper pulling techniques, secured at regular intervals, and protected from mechanical stress and environmental exposure. Planning and Preparation Before installation, conduct a thorough site survey to identify tower locations, potential hazards, and access points. Securing the Cable Fix the cable to the tower at regular intervals: typically 0.8–1 meter vertically and 1 meter horizontally. Use clamps of appropriate diameter to avoid crushing the cable and ensure it does not touch the tower structure at any point. For interior monopoles, cables can be freely hung with adequate hoisting grips and secured at entry and exit points.

Protection and Environmental Considerations Use PE jackets with UV protection for outdoor aerial cables to prevent degradation from sunlight. Avoid sharp bends and maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer. If the cable remains exposed for extended periods during installation, use protective material to prevent mechanical damage. Ensure that metallic components of the cable are kept clear of power lines to prevent electrical hazards.
